

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be received by the Office of the Secretary of the District, Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District (District) either by U.S. Postal Service addressed to its mailing address, P.O. Box 9000, Presidio Station, San Francisco, CA 94129-0601, or by courier or personal delivery to its office at the Administration Building, Golden Gate Bridge Toll Plaza, San Francisco, CA, on **Tuesday, August 31, 2010, by 2:00 p.m., Pacific Standard Time**, at which time bids will be publicly opened and read in the Board Room of said building for the following:

LARKSPUR FERRY TERMINAL UTILITY REHABILITATION **CITY OF LARKSPUR, COUNTY OF MARIN, CALIFORNIA**

This Public Works Project consists of, in general, rehabilitation of existing utility system at the Larkspur Ferry Terminal. The Work includes replacing sewer and bilge pipelines; replacing bilge tanks; installing bilge pumps and compressed air pipelines; replacing or installing pipe and conduit supports; modifying steel pipe railing; installing steel pump modules and support frames; resurfacing concrete slab and installing steel sump box; providing temporary bilge tank; and all other related work items; health and safety compliance; water pollution control; access by watercraft; temporary scaffold and work platform; temporary sanitary facilities; construction phasing; and furnishing all additional labor, materials, tools, equipment, services, supervision, and incidental work items as required to complete the Project titled *Larkspur Ferry Terminal Utility Rehabilitation*, as shown on the Contract Plans and as specified in the Contract Documents.

A pre-bid conference will be held on Tuesday, August 10, 2010, at 11:00 a.m., Pacific Standard Time, at the Administration Building, Golden Gate Bridge Toll Plaza, San Francisco, CA. While this conference is not mandatory, District highly recommends you attend.

Bidders bidding as the prime contractor shall possess a valid **State of California Class A General Engineering Contractor's License** with minimum of three (3) projects' experience with public agencies in the past five (5) years at the time of bid opening. All subcontractors, if any, shall be properly licensed by the State of California to perform specialized trades. Additionally, piping subcontractor shall have minimum of three (3) completed projects of piping experience in the past five (5) years. Bidder shall submit satisfactory qualifications/ experience listed above in bidding documents.

District hereby notifies all Bidders that it is the policy of District to ensure nondiscrimination on the basis of race, color, sex or national origin in the award and administration of contracts. Bidders are strongly encouraged to obtain Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) participation on this Project, although there is no contract-specific DBE goal. Bidders are encouraged to attend the pre-bid conference to better understand the applicable DBE requirements. For DBE assistance contact Gail Jackson, DBE Program Administrator, at (415) 257-4581.

Bids shall be submitted on District's "PROPOSAL" Forms in a sealed envelope and plainly marked with Bidder's name.

Bids must be accompanied by a deposit either in the form of cash, a certified or cashier's check, or Bidder's bond, as described in the Contract Documents, which shall be applied to damages sustained by District if the successful Bidder fails or refuses to enter into a Contract awarded to it.

District reserves the right to reject any and all bids or to waive any irregularities or informalities in any bid or in the bidding procedure. No Bidder may withdraw its bid for a period of ninety (90) days after the date of opening bids. Within two (2) working days of bid opening, a summary of Bidders' quotes will be available at the District's website. To review the bid results, go to the District's website home page at <http://www.goldengate.org>, click on Contract Opportunities. Then scroll down to Ferry Division and look for Contract No. 2011-FT-3. Each Bidder will be notified of award, if award is made.

The successful Bidder shall furnish a performance bond and a payment bond in amounts equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the total price of the Contract.

This Contract is subject to financial assistance from the U.S. Department of Transportation. Bidders will be required to certify that they have not been suspended or debarred from participation in federally funded contracts. Bidders must also disclose lobbying activities. Full compliance with all applicable Safety and Health Standards, DBE requirements, Equal Employment Opportunity, and Americans with Disabilities Act laws and regulations will be required of the successful Bidder.

This is a Public Works Contract. In accordance with Section 1720 et seq. of the Labor Code, the general prevailing wage rates as established by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations will apply to this Contract. Information about prevailing wage rates for this Project is set forth in the Special Provisions. The prevailing wage rates established by the California Department of Industrial Relations are available at <http://www.dir.ca.gov/DLSR/#PWD>. Hard copies can be viewed at the District's Engineering Office or requested by mail, addressed to: Prevailing Wage Unit, Division of Labor Statistics and Research, Department of Industrial Relations, P.O. Box 420603, San Francisco, CA 94142.

Should the general prevailing wage rates not specify a wage determination for a particular craft classification or type of worker, attention is directed to 8 CCR 16202(b) regarding petitioning the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations for a special wage determination. District has made no request for such determination as District does not know the specific craft classifications or type of workers intended by Contractor for this Project.

Minimum wage rates for this Project, as determined by the U.S. Secretary of Labor, are set forth in the Special Provisions, Section 10A. If there is a difference between the minimum wage rates determined by the Secretary of Labor and the prevailing wage rates determined by the State for similar classifications of labor, Contractor and its subcontractors shall pay no less than the higher wage rate.

Pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 22300, the successful Bidder may submit certain securities in lieu of the District withholding funds from progress payments (retention) during the Project.

Bidders' attention is directed to the requirements of the Occupational Safety and Health Administration of the U.S. Department of Labor, which requirements shall apply to all work to be done under this Contract.

District will post any pre-bid questions and responses on District's website. To review any pre-bid questions and responses, go to District's website home page at <http://www.goldengate.org>, click on Contract Opportunities, scroll down to Ferry Division and look for Contract No. 2011-FT-3. Bidders are encouraged to check the website regularly.

Bid Documents, consisting of the Notice to Contractors, General Conditions, Special Provisions, Technical Specifications, Contract Plans, Proposal Forms, Bonds, Contract Forms, and Addenda are available for download at no charge on District's website. To download the Documents, go to District's website home page at <http://www.goldengate.org>, click on Contract Opportunities, scroll down to Ferry Division and look for Contract No. 2011-FT-3. For those who wish to download Bid Documents from District's website, your name will not appear on District's "List of Potential Bidders" unless you notify the Office of the Secretary of the District. District requests that all prospective Bidders who download Bid Documents complete the "List of Potential Bidders" form in Word format, posted with Bid Documents, and return the form to the Office of the Secretary of the District. Ultimately, it is the responsibility of Bidder to check District's website for any Addenda that may be issued relative to this Contract.
