BRIDGE TRAFFIC FOR THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY 2007

Bridge traffic for the month of February increased .10% to 2,877,086 vehicles as compared to the previous year's total of 2,874,256 vehicles during the month of February. Average daily traffic reflects an increase from 102,652 in February 2006, to 102,753 in February 2007. The highest traffic day recorded was Friday, February 16 when 118,504 vehicles crossed the Bridge (Attachment 1).

⁽¹⁾ Autos with Trailers, 3-Axle Buses, and Trucks are now categorized as Multi-Axle Vehicles; 2-Axle Buses and Trucks are now under 2-Axle Vehicles, as of January 1, 2000.

⁽²⁾ Army, Navy, and Air Force vehicles and personnel required to use the Golden Gate Bridge are entitled to toll-free passage under Federal law.

⁽³⁾ Statistics for CHP and District vehicles were not compiled prior to July 7, 1970; Compilation of Golden Gate Transit Buses began January 1, 1992.

⁽⁴⁾ Free passage for carpools commenced April 12, 1976. Free vehicles occurred in October of 1989, due to heavy traffic after the Loma-Prieta earthquake.

⁽⁵⁾ This figure is DOUBLE the Monthly Total of ALL SOUTHBOUND vehicles to determine an estimate of total Vehicles for BOTH Northbound AND Southbound traffic.
