QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES FROM POTENTIAL BIDDERS

Question 1: What is the last day for RFIs and questions?

Response 1: Please refer to Special Provisions Section 2, Paragraph S2.06, Addenda and Explanation. This Section states that questions shall be submitted no later than ten (10) calendar days prior to bid opening.

Question 2: Do the insurance liability limits apply to subcontractors, specifically from Item F. Contractor's Pollution Legal Liability? Please advise.

Response 2: Prime Contractor is responsible for providing all insurance to the District. All insurance requirements are listed in the Proposal Section, Page P-5 and the Special Provisions, Section 7, Paragraph 7.11, Insurance Provisions, Page SP 7-11 to SP 7-12.

Question 3: Please clarify the following:

In the General Conditions, G7.24 Insurance Provisions Item (a) General and Automobile Liability Insurance (1) state "the policy or policies shall provide a minimum limit of \$5,000,000 each occurrence/\$5,000,000 each accident." Item G7.24 (a)(2) states "the policy or policies shall provide a minimum limit of \$5,000,000 each accident." Attachment C of the Proposal Items C & D shows the limits at \$2,000,000 per occurrence/accident & \$2,000,000 in the annual aggregate.

- Please clarify if the limits are to be \$5,000,000 each occurrence/accident as stated in the General Conditions or \$2,000,000 each occurrence/accident as shown in the Proposal.

Response 3: Please refer to the Proposal Section, Page P-5 and Special Provisions Section 7, Paragraph S7.11, Insurance Provisions, Page SP 7-11 to SP 7-12. The insurance provisions are spelled out in these Sections.
