Dear Transit District Official,

I'm writing in support of continued service of Golden Gate Transit Line 92. This office of 11 persons located in Sausalito is very much dependent on this bus line for weekday commute for over half of the staff, and we would be affected adversely by this discontinuation.


Based on reportage by the *Marin Independent Journal*, Route 92 ridership currently meets the service standard of 10 riders per trip for the commute shuttle, and in fact exceeds this District standard by averaging 13.5 passengers per trip.

The proposed alternative services will delay arrivals to Sausalito by 30 minutes, and force riders to leave 30 minutes early in order to catch the return trip. This adds up to a lost productivity of 25 hours per week, an annual total lost productivity of 1,250 hours. Financially, each employee must now shoulder an additional \$5 per day to add in a trip each way on SF Muni that was not required previously (an additional \$1,250 per year, per employee).

Additionally, it is likely that the discontinued service will push some of these employees into adding to the car traffic on the Golden Gate Bridge, an estimated additional 500 car trips per person, per year.

Please consider these impacts to our employees and to our business, and to the other employees and businesses affected by this adverse change in service.
