Subject: **MONTHLY REPORT ON BRIDGE TRAFFIC, TRANSIT
RIDERSHIP TRENDS, AND TRANSIT SERVICE PERFORMANCE**

Provided for the Committee's information are ten months of charts showing monthly trends updated to reflect August 2019 through May 2020. There were positive indicators in performance in Bridge, Bus and Ferry through February 2020. Note that these statistics are reported in the "year-over-year" 12-month annualized format that has been traditionally used and do not fully reflect the steep decline in Bridge traffic and transit ridership experienced beginning in March 2020 when the shelter-in-place orders related to the COVID-19 pandemic were issued. Bridge traffic declined by about 70% of normal with the advent of COVID-19, while transit ridership declined even more sharply with an 85% decline on Golden Gate Transit bus and 98% on Golden Gate Ferry. The year-over-year data is presented in the following format:

- Golden Gate Bridge – southbound 12-month running totals of vehicular traffic as recorded in the toll lanes, southbound monthly averages of 5:00 a.m. – 9:00 a.m. weekday commute period traffic, and southbound monthly averages of 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. weekday commute period traffic;
- Golden Gate Ferry – 12-month running totals of boarding passengers as recorded in the daily vessel logs; and,
- Golden Gate Transit Regional Bus – 12-month running totals of boarding passengers as recorded in on-board fare collection equipment.

Golden Gate Bridge: The below table summarizes August 2019 through February 2020 year over year 12-month running Bridge traffic changes in southbound a.m. peak period traffic, p.m. peak period traffic, and total traffic compared with August 2018 through February 2019.

Transit Service Performance Statistics Report: The Transit Service Performance Statistics Reports for the months of August 2019 through May 2020 show Golden Gate Bus and Golden Gate Ferry operations relative to performance targets set forth in the District's Short-Range Transit Plan. Below are selected metrics broken out by single (non-annualized) month. Note that the steep declines in performance statistics for March, April and May 2020 reflect the ridership declines due to the shelter-in-place orders related to the COVID-19 pandemic.
