

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO
RECEIVE PUBLIC COMMENT ON THE PROPOSED ESTABLISHMENT OF A PILOT
PROGRAM FOR AN EDUCATIONAL/INSTITUTIONAL CLIPPER PASS ON
GOLDEN GATE TRANSIT BUS AND GOLDEN GATE FERRY**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District (District) will hold a Public Hearing to receive public comment, as follows:

The District would like to establish a pilot program for a new fare category to be contained in the District's Clipper Fare Program that would provide a fare discount through a monthly pass to riders bound for designated higher educational institutions or specified major employers on Golden Gate Transit (GGT) regional routes and regular (non-special event) Golden Gate Ferry (GGF) service. The Clipper pass is intended to work with the payment systems of all other transit operators in the Bay Area, and would allow riders to get to their destination for a reduced cost. In Phase I that begins in August 2022, the pilot program would apply to travel to select major educational institutions, and in Phase 2 that begins in 2023, the pilot program would be extended to travel to identified major employers in locations that have a density of transit service such as those that operate in the San Francisco, Oakland, and San Jose downtown areas.

Participants including students and residents of specified housing developments would receive the Clipper pass for travel to designated higher educational institutions at no cost. In the second phase of the project, the passes would be sold to specified employers for a 'to be determined' cost.
