Subject: <u>DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO TERMINATE THE</u>

SUSPENSION OF BOARD PROCEDURAL RULES AND POLICIES FOR

COVID-19 RELATED EMERGENCY ACTIONS

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Directors consider possible action to terminate the suspension of Board Procedural Rules and Policies for COVID-19 related emergency actions.

Resolution 2020-017 authorized the temporary suspension of Board procedural rules and policies to allow the timely execution of emergency actions during the COVID-19 pandemic, consistent with federal, state, regional and local public health mandates. Resolution 2020-017 provides that the Board will review and consider at each subsequent regularly scheduled meeting, whether to terminate the suspension of Board procedural rules and policies.

Public health directives, including specific requirements for employers, continue in effect and are periodically modified to impose and/or ease additional requirements. Also, there is tremendous uncertainty regarding how travel might return in the Golden Gate Corridor as businesses and community activities continue to revise their reopening plans. On a daily basis, the District must respond to changing conditions and modify its operations as circumstances warrant. It is crucial for the District to be nimble and responsive to ever-changing needs during this period.

It is therefore recommended that the suspension of Board procedural rules and policies not be terminated at this time. The Board will again review this matter at the next regular Board meeting in October 2022.

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
