Subject: **MONTHLY REPORT ON BRIDGE TRAFFIC, TRANSIT RIDERSHIP  
TRENDS, AND TRANSIT SERVICE PERFORMANCE**

This report includes information showing monthly data for travel in the Golden Gate Corridor updated through December 2022 with the data for each month compared to the same month pre-pandemic. Information is collected as follows:

- Golden Gate Bridge – monthly southbound vehicular traffic as recorded in the toll lanes, southbound monthly averages of 5:00 a.m. – 9:00 a.m. weekday commute period traffic, and southbound monthly averages of 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. weekday commute period traffic;
- Golden Gate Ferry – monthly totals of boarding passengers as recorded in the daily vessel logs; and,
- Golden Gate Transit Bus – monthly totals of boarding passengers as recorded in on-board fare collection equipment.

Golden Gate Bridge:

To present a snapshot of the most recent data trends, the table below summarizes March 2020 through December 2022 single-month Bridge traffic changes in southbound a.m. peak period traffic, p.m. peak period traffic, and total traffic compared with March 2019 through December 2019.

Golden Gate Ferry (GGF):

Transit Service Performance Statistics Report: The Transit Service Performance Statistics Reports for the months of August 2019 through December 2022 show Golden Gate Bus and Golden Gate Ferry operations relative to performance targets set forth in the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District’s Short-Range Transit Plan. Below are selected metrics broken out by single (non-annualized) month. Note that the steep declines in performance for March 2020 through December 2022 reflect the ridership declines due to the shelter-in-place orders related to the pandemic.
