Subject: AUTHORIZE BUDGET ADJUSTMENT(S) AND/OR TRANSFER(S)

(a) BUDGET INCREASE IN THE FY 23/24 BRIDGE DIVISION CAPITAL BUDGET FOR PROJECT #1923, GOLDEN GATE

SUSPENSION BRIDGE SEISMIC RETROFIT

## **Recommendation**

The Finance-Auditing Committee recommends that the Board of Directors authorize the following actions relative to Project #1923, *Golden Gate Suspension Bridge Seismic Retrofit – Phase IIIB CM/GC*, as follows:

- 1. Rename Project #1923 in the FY 23/24 Bridge Division Capital Budget to the *Golden Gate Suspension Bridge Seismic Retrofit*; and,
- 2. Authorize an increase in the FY 23/24 Bridge Division Capital Budget, in the amount of \$1,443,663, for Project #1923, *Golden Gate Suspension Bridge Seismic Retrofit*, to be funded with 100% unspent Federal Highway Administration funds from Projects #9102 and #9206 (Seismic Retrofit 3 Design and 3A Construction, respectively).

This matter will be presented to the Board of Directors at its August 25, 2023, meeting for appropriate action.

## **Summary**

On April 26, 2019, the Board authorized the establishment of Project #1923, *Golden Gate Suspension Bridge Seismic Retrofit* (previously Golden Gate Bridge Seismic Retrofit *Phase IIIB CM/GC*), in the Bridge Division Capital Budget, to be funded with 100% unspent Federal Highway Administration funds from Projects #9102 and #9206 (Seismic Retrofit 3 Design and 3A Construction, respectively). Also on April 26, 2019, the Board authorized transfer of all unspent funds of up to \$9,953,800 to Project #1923 once the close-outs for Projects #9102 and #9206 were finalized. Unspent funds in the amount of \$9,861,844 were ultimately transferred by Caltrans in 2019 to Project #1923.

Following that action, Caltrans authorized additional unused federal earmark funds from previous completed phases of the Golden Gate Bridge Seismic Retrofit project to support Project Construction Engineering], in the amount of \$1,443,663, for transfer to Project #1923. District staff obligated these funds and now recommend Board approval to increase the project budget to be in alignment with the obligated federal funding amount.

## **Fiscal Impact**

Project #1923, Golden Gate Suspension Bridge Seismic Retrofit, was approved in the FY 23/24 Bridge Division Capital Budget for \$9,861,844. The District obligated an additional \$1,443,663 in Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) funds for Construction Engineering, comprised of unused FHWA funds from Projects #9102 and #9206 (Seismic Retrofit 3 Design and 3A Construction, respectively). To bring the District project budget in line with the federal obligation, approval of this item will result in a \$1,443,663 increase to the total project budget. The revised total project budget of \$11,305,507 will be 100% FHWA-funded. There is no impact to District funds associated with this item.
