**REPORT OF THE ATTORNEY
BOARD OF DIRECTORS
MEETING OF February 27, 2026**

President Hill and Members of the Board:

Set forth below is a status report of legal matters on which Hanson Bridgett has worked since our last written report presented at the January 23, 2026, meeting of the Board of Directors.

In addition to provision of day-to-day assistance and advice, such as attendance at E-Team, Committee and Board meetings; review of draft minutes and staff reports, resolutions and ordinances; and, assistance with on-going personnel and labor relations matters, our time has been devoted to assisting the District and its operating divisions with the following specific matters:

District:

- **District Division Procurements:** Assisted District staff with procurement matters including the cloud hosting services first amendment; first amendment to environmental testing services; the on-call cyber security services contract; job posting and advertising services agreement; TPA for workers' compensation, claim administration, and ancillary services contract; EJ Ward onsite diagnosis and maintenance services; SBE program memo; the emergency electrical repair memo; the PAF for the brochure distribution services amendment; the ITCS nextGen Phase 2 upgrade and system migration amendment; the INIT amendment; fifth amendment to the radio upgrade consultant agreement; janitorial services contract; the PAF for window washing services; the Brinks agreement; 12th amendment to customer communication services platform; Lincoln Boulevard undercrossing emergency temporary barrier installation contract; the OPEB Agreement; trust and investment management services contract; the Larkspur shuttle amendment; revisions to the USBAM agreement; the FTA notice for period of performance end dates and active grants; and, the change order for task order 5 to grants management agreement.
