**REPORT OF THE ATTORNEY  
BOARD OF DIRECTORS  
MEETING OF June 26, 2026**



President Rabbit and Members of the Board:

Set forth below is a status report of legal matters on which Hanson Bridgett has worked since our last written report presented at the May 22, 2026, meeting of the Board of Directors.

In addition to provision of day-to-day assistance and advice, such as attendance at E-Team, Committee and Board meetings; review of draft minutes and staff reports, resolutions and ordinances; and, assistance with on-going personnel and labor relations matters, our time has been devoted to assisting the District and its operating divisions with the following specific matters:

***District:***

- **District Division Procurements:** Assisted District staff with procurement matters including: fourth amendment for analyst on demand services; drug testing services contract; drug and alcohol testing agreement; on-call cyber security services; EUNA agreement; agreement with LEGO; procurement of CivicPlus products for ADA compliance; radio upgrade contract; second amendment to Tait Agreement; ARCPoint Labs of San Rafael agreement; San Rafael parking lot improvement and solar panel installation matters; DOT collection services agreement; Brink's agreement; the Circaworks agreement; the INIT software amendment; seventh amendment to Misson Critical Partners agreement, Mt. Tamalpais license agreement; and, OnBase consultation services. Multiple PAFs included the fourth amendment to digital communication management platform; second amendment to mobile drug and alcohol laboratory services agreement; and staging rental for Fort Point Arch scaffold.
- **District Division Matters:** Provided assistance and advice to staff in connection with updates to templates; lost and found policy; Public Records Act requests; AB 334 and AB 2374 review and draft proposed amendments; training requirements under SB 827 for Fiscal and Financial training; PAF information to unions; opinion of counsel letter; SB 827 training sessions; and, the new IT template requirements.

***Bridge Division:***

***Bus Division:***

- **Bus Division Matters/Procurement:** Provided assistance and advice to staff in connection with various Bus Division matters, including San Rafael Bus Facility water line modifications engineering design services; stop notice matter on the San Rafael Bus Facility parking lot improvements project; the third GIRO amendment and negotiation for Hastus maintenance and support services; the SMS implementation documentation and presentation; Goodyear tires performance issues matter; safety notice and near-miss documentation; safety bulletin, ASP/SMS training presentation; review and revise bus safety assaults presentation; GGT/MCTD operations agreement negotiations and contract extension proposal; reporting feedback loop process; legal risks related to ASP documentation; bus shelter removal; implementing recommendations from Safety Committee; and, EV Charging Program and Bus ESS3 Refresh PAF.
- **Labor Negotiations:** Provided assistance with the ATU contract and pension issues.

***Ferry Division:***

- **Ferry Division Matters/Procurement:** Provided assistance and advice to District staff in connection with various Ferry Division matters, including approve first amendment for metallurgical testing; building permit request for Sausalito project; the scheduled drydocking and capital improvements for MV Golden Gate; Northern Lights generator inspection and repair contract and change order; RFP for scheduled drydocking and capital improvements for MS San Francisco; on-call marine propulsion systems maintenance contract; the first amendment to ferry fleet condition assessment agreement; GGF procurement, amendment to SFFT west/east berth ramp rehab project; LIWA vessel 1 and 2 Buy America compliance memo; LIWA Vessels 1 and 2 engines; draft contract with HamiltonJet Inc. for Belzona tailpipe coatings; Sausalito lease agreement; and, emergency support services SF Inner Berth agreement. PAFs included the emergency support services for SF Ramp; emergency repair services for MV Napa starboard generator; task order #22 for on-call MTU engine maintenance and repair parts; and, fuel farm motor control panel upgrade.
- **The Larkspur Ferry Terminal (LFT):** Assisted staff with the cabling project; RFQ/RFP berth and channel maintenance dredging and permit support services; SBE goal recommendation; and, the RFP for the mooring camels refurbishment.
