




About AC Transit








 - Audited Financial Overhead Statements/Memos
- Attend Pre-Bid/ Proposal Conferences, Outreach Events
 - Understand project expectations
 - Network with key project staff
 - Boost potential for teaming opportunities
- Request a Debrief on Unsuccessful Proposals
- Stay Informed
 - Periodically review AC Transit website for contracting opportunities
 - Review past procurements for prior bids and types of contracts offered
- Get Certified
