

A capital improvement project is any major improvement to City facilities and infrastructure. Projects may include construction renovation or replacement of City buildings, parks, and pools, repaving of streets, traffic signal upgrades and coordination, and replacement or installation of new water, sewer and stormwater lines. Collectively, these projects are referred to as Capital Improvement Projects. Capital improvement projects are varied, so some may require years of planning and construction while others may be completed in a shorter timeframe.


