

Interstate Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE)/ Airport Concession Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (ACDBE) Certification Overview



Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, prohibits discrimination based upon <u>race, color, and national origin</u>. Specifically, 42 USC 2000d states that "No person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance.

Interstate Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Airport Concession Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (ACDBE):

DBE/ACDBE Interstate Certification applies to firms who are already certified in their home state and seeking certification in another state, i.e. California or territories of the United States.

Interstate Certification

- Firms must be certified in their home state before seeking certification in another state.
- The new state certifying agency will request the on-site report from the home state.
- Out-of-state businesses may be requested to submit a complete package of all the documents originally submitted to their home state.
- Interstate certification is not automatic reciprocity; CUCP members review other states' determinations, along with all supporting documentation.



Required Documents

- Completed Interstate Supplemental Application
- Personal Net Worth Statement
- Notices or Correspondence from States other than your home state
- Inform CUCP of appeals



California Unified Certification Program

Welcome to the California Unified Certification Program Certification Portal! The CAUCP is responsible for DBE certification in the state of California and provides firms with "one-stop" shopping.

To apply for DBE certification you may contact any one of the ten CUCP Certifying Partners -Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transit Authority (LA Metro), San Diego County Regional Airport Authority (SDCRAA), San Francisco Bay Area Rapid Transit District (BART), San Francisco International Airport (SFO), San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA), San Mateo County Transit District (SAMTrans), Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA), City of Los Angeles, City of Fresno, California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) - by clicking on their logo.
