Position Summary

Under supervision of the Ironworker Superintendent, will be trained in and perform maintenance, repair and construction of the Bridge and other District facilities.

Essential Responsibilities

- Performs maintenance, repair and replacement of steel components and fasteners on the Bridge and other District facilities.
- Performs rigging for other crafts.
- Installs and repairs chain link and other fencing.
- Fabricates steel items in the shop and erects structural and miscellaneous steel items.
- Places reinforcing steel for concrete.
- Knows and follows the safety and health rules and safe working practices applicable to his or her job.
- Establishes and maintains effective working relationships with District employees, customers, vendors and all others contacted during the course of work using principles of excellent customer service.
- Performs additional related duties as assigned
- Regular and reliable attendance and performance is required

Required Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

Knowledge of:

- Occupational health and safety rules and working practices applicable to this position

Skill in or Ability to:

- Read and understand working drawings.
- Work closely with others.
- Adhere to safe work practices.
- Maintain a good attendance record.
- Attend weekly classes.



Minimum Qualifications

Education and/or Experience: High school diploma or GED equivalent; previous Ironworker experience preferred; AND present enrollment in an Ironworker Apprenticeship program.

Required License: Must possess and maintain a current, valid California driver's license and satisfactory driving record. No reckless driving and DUI infractions within the last 7 years. No more than 2 moving violations within the last 3 years. May operate District vehicles.

Physical Requirements: Must be able to perform heavy manual labor. Work is performed outside in varying weather conditions. Must be able to stoop, bend, push, pull, and lift up to 50 pounds. Will be required to wear a respirator, or other personal protective equipment involving full body protection. Must be able to work comfortably at considerable heights from platforms, ladders, floats or suspended scaffolds; climb and walk on the Bridge cables; and climb ladders.

This position may have a potential for or actual exposure to lead. Pursuant to OSHA regulations, District employees are not exposed to lead at concentrations greater than 10 micrograms per cubic meter ($\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$) of air averaged over an 8-hour period.
