SMART/Golden Gate Transit Connections

To/From San Francisco
UPDATED Spring 2023
Effective March 12, 2023

Description of Service

Golden Gate Transit (GGT) buses are located at the San Rafael Transit Center (SRTC), directly across the street from the San Rafael SMART Station. Do NOT take SMART to the end of the line (Larkspur Station), unless you plan to ride Golden Gate Ferry to San Francisco.

The most convenient connections are shown on the timetables on the reverse, but check online (goldengate.org) or in the *Golden Gate Transit Guide* for a complete list of trips.

Southbound Routes 101, 130, and 150 depart from the southeast end (corner of Second and Heatherston Streets) of Platform A. Route 132 also departs from Platform A, but buses board mid-platform. Check overhead signs for boarding locations.

Transfer Credits

Fare credits are available on Clipper only. SMART accepts GGT transfers for a \$1.50 credit for adults (\$1.25 for youths, \$0.75 for senior/disabled). GGT accepts SMART transfers for \$1.50 for adults (\$0.75 for youth/senior/disabled). Credits are only issued when using e-cash value (not passes). No credits for SMART app tickets (eTickets).

Bikes on Golden Gate Transit

All GGT buses are equipped with bike racks. Buses that do not have exterior front racks have underbelly bike racks. Some San Francisco bus stops prevent the use of the underbelly bike racks due to safety or operational reasons (see list at goldengate.org/bikes-ggt).

Trip Planning

For trip-planning assistance, visit goldengate.org or call 511 (say "Golden Gate Transit," then "operator" to bypass recorded messages)/TDD 711. The customer Service Center is open weekdays from 7 am to 6 pm.

Descripción del servicio

Los autobuses de Golden Gate Transit (GGT) se encuentran en el Centro de Tránsito de San Rafael (SRTC), directamente enfrente de la estación SMART de San Rafael. No tome SMART hasta el final de la línea (la estación de Larkspur), a menos que planea viajar por Golden Gate Ferry a San Francisco.

Las conexiones más convenientes se muestran en el reverso de los horarios, pero consulte (goldengate.org) o la *Golden Gate Transit Guide* para ver una lista completa de viajes.

Las rutas 101, 130 y 150 con rumbo al sur salen del extremo sureste de la plataforma A (esquina de las calles Second y Heatherston). La ruta 132 también sale de la plataforma A, pero se abordan los autobuses a mitad de la plataforma. Consulte las pantallas elevadas para ver los puntos de abordaje

Créditos de transbordo

SMART acepta transbordos de GGT para un crédito de tarifa de \$1.50 para adultos (\$1.25 para jóvenes, \$0.75 para adultos mayores/discapacitados). GGT acepta transbordos de SMART por \$1.50 para adultos (\$0.75 para jóvenes/adultos mayores/discapacitados). Los créditos de tarifa solo se expiden cuando se usa efectivo electrónico (no pases) en Clipper. No se expiden créditos de transbordo si se usan boletos de la aplicación SMART (boletos electrónicos) o efectivo.

Bicicletas en Golden Gate Transit

Todos los autobuses de GGT están equipados con rejilla portabicicletas. Los autobuses que no tienen rejilla exterior delantera tienen una rejilla por debajo del autobús. Algunas paradas de autobús en San Francisco impiden el uso de la rejilla inferior debido a razones de seguridad u operacionales (ver la lista en goldengatetransit.org/bikes).
