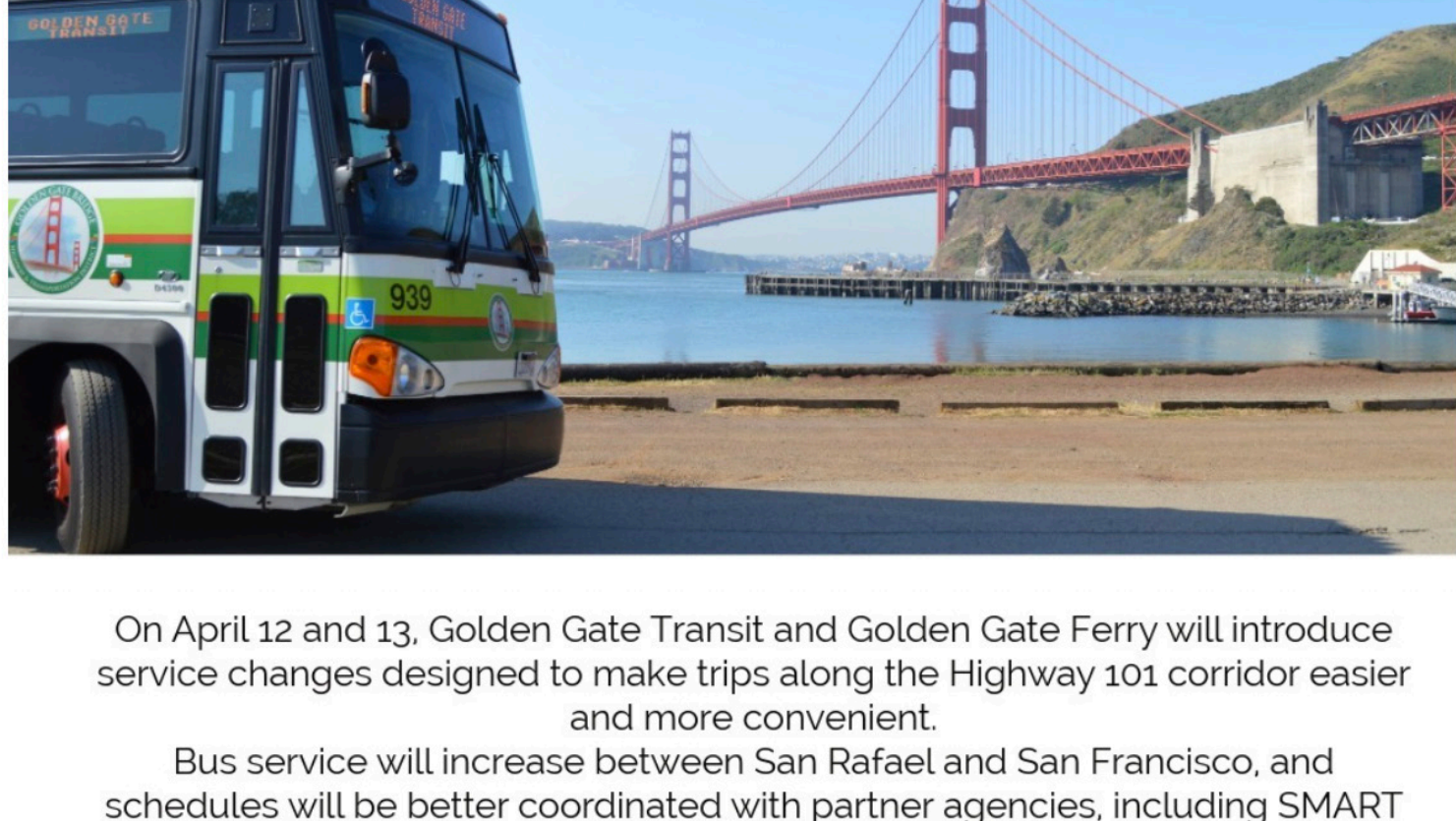

### Golden Gate Transit and Golden Gate Ferry Service Changes Coming in April



On April 12 and 13, Golden Gate Transit and Golden Gate Ferry will introduce service changes designed to make trips along the Highway 101 corridor easier and more convenient.

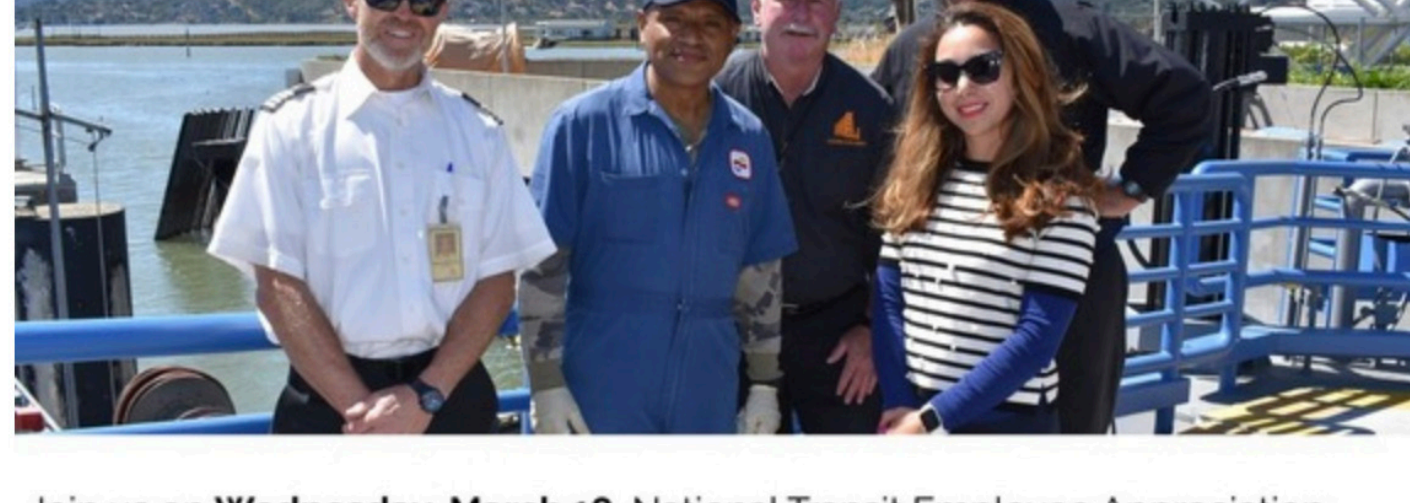
Bus service will increase between San Rafael and San Francisco, and schedules will be better coordinated with partner agencies, including SMART and Marin Transit, to improve connections and travel options for riders to Sonoma County and within Marin County.

These updates are part of the Marin-Sonoma Coordinated Transit Services (MASCOTS) plan, a regional effort by nine transit and funding agencies to improve public transit in the corridor.

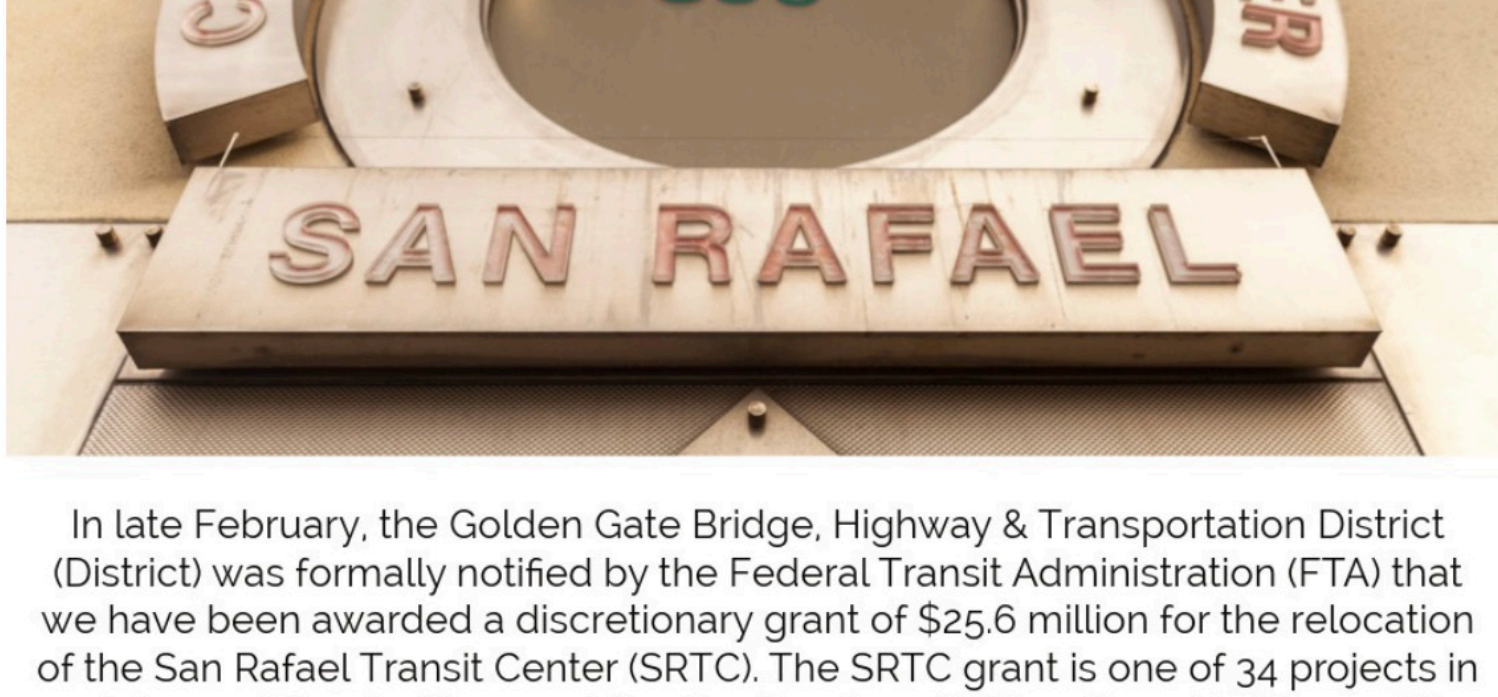

### District Awarded \$25.6M Federal Grant for SRTC Relocation Project



In late February, the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway & Transportation District (District) was formally notified by the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) that we have been awarded a discretionary grant of \$25.6 million for the relocation of the San Rafael Transit Center (SRTC). The SRTC grant is one of 34 projects in 19 states and Puerto Rico receiving funding from FTA's nationwide Bus and Facilities grant program this cycle, and it was the largest award in our region.

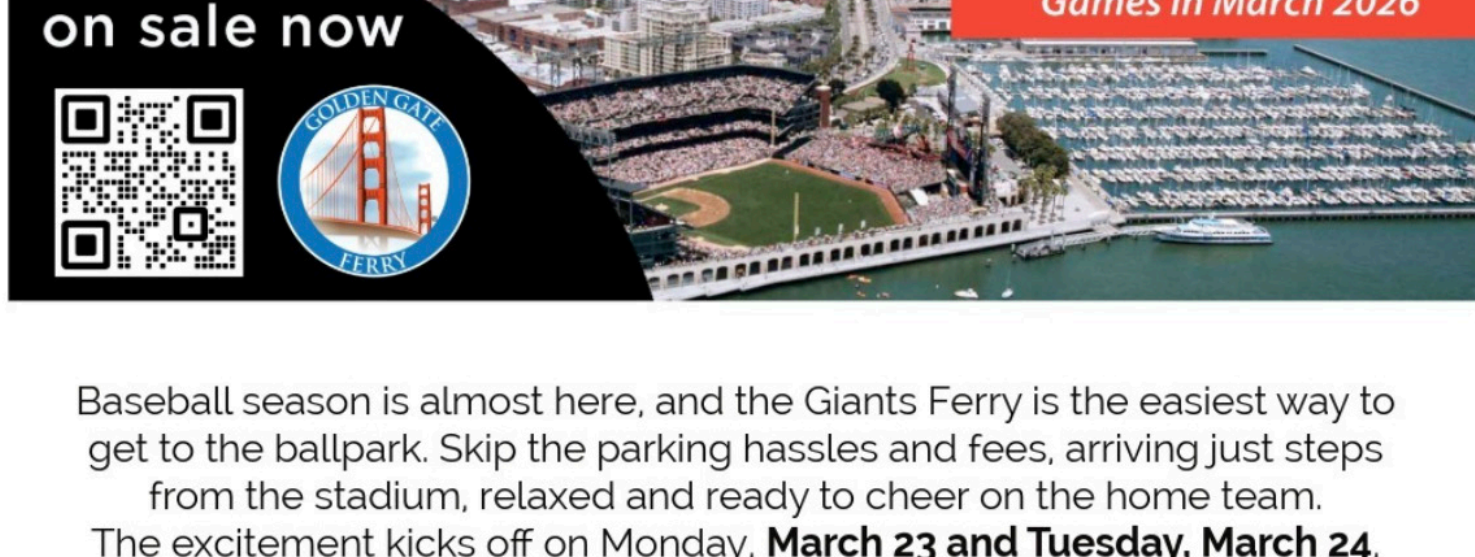
This new grant funding is a major step towards completing the funding package for the project. The SRTC relocation project is currently in federal environmental review, with construction expected to begin in 2027.

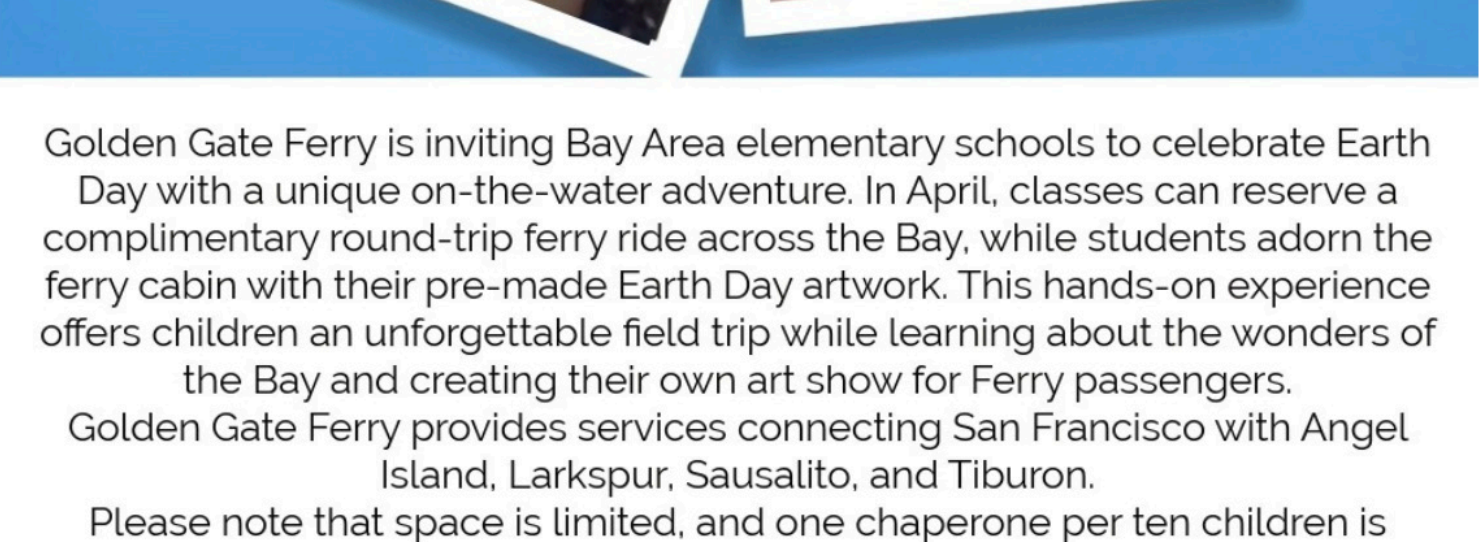
The excitement kicks off on Monday, **March 23** and **Tuesday, March 24**, when the Giants host the Sultanes de Monterrey for two exhibition games.

### Decorate Golden Gate Ferry for Earth Day!



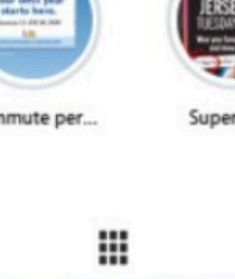

Please note that space is limited, and one chaperone per ten children is recommended.

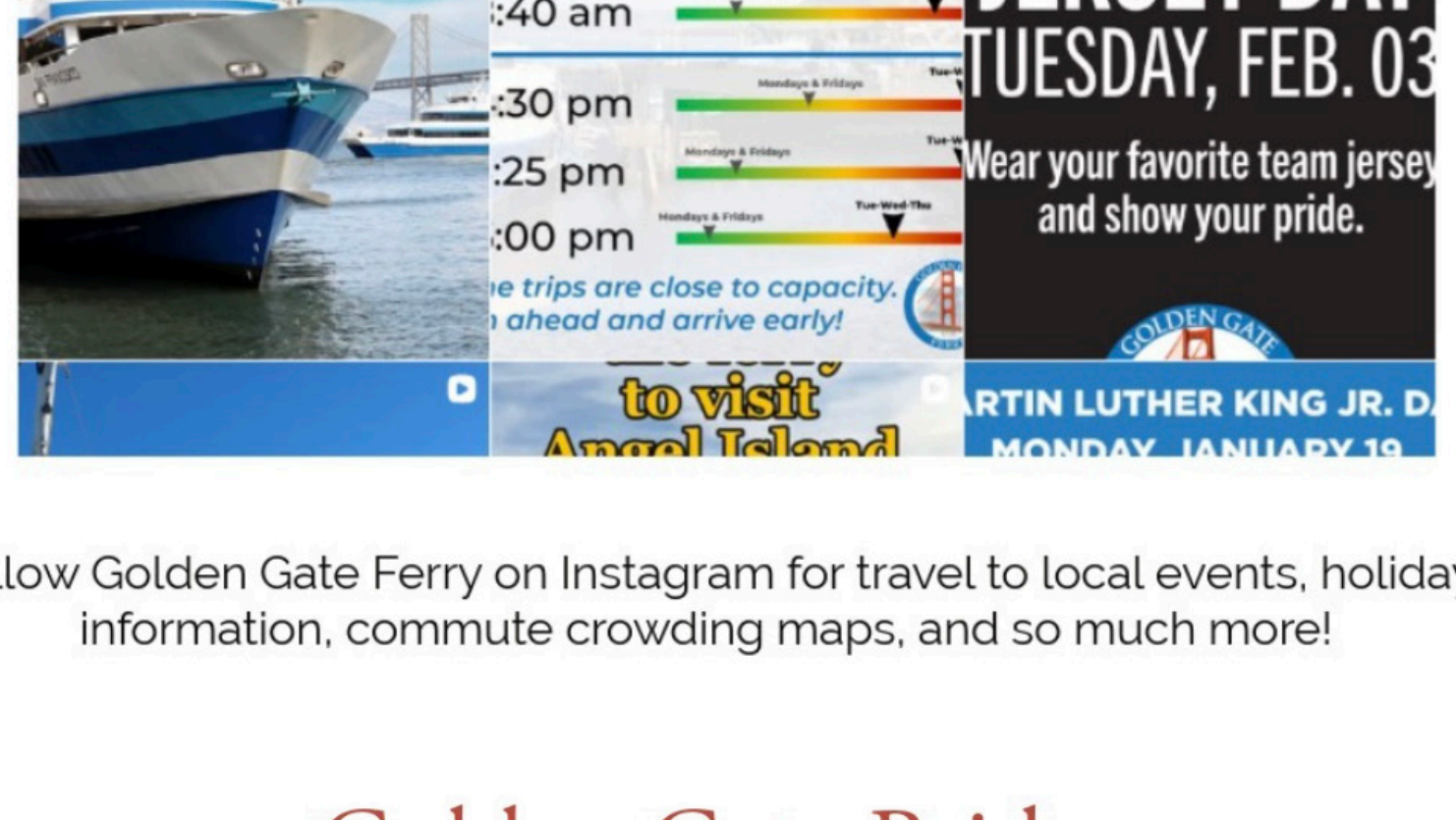
