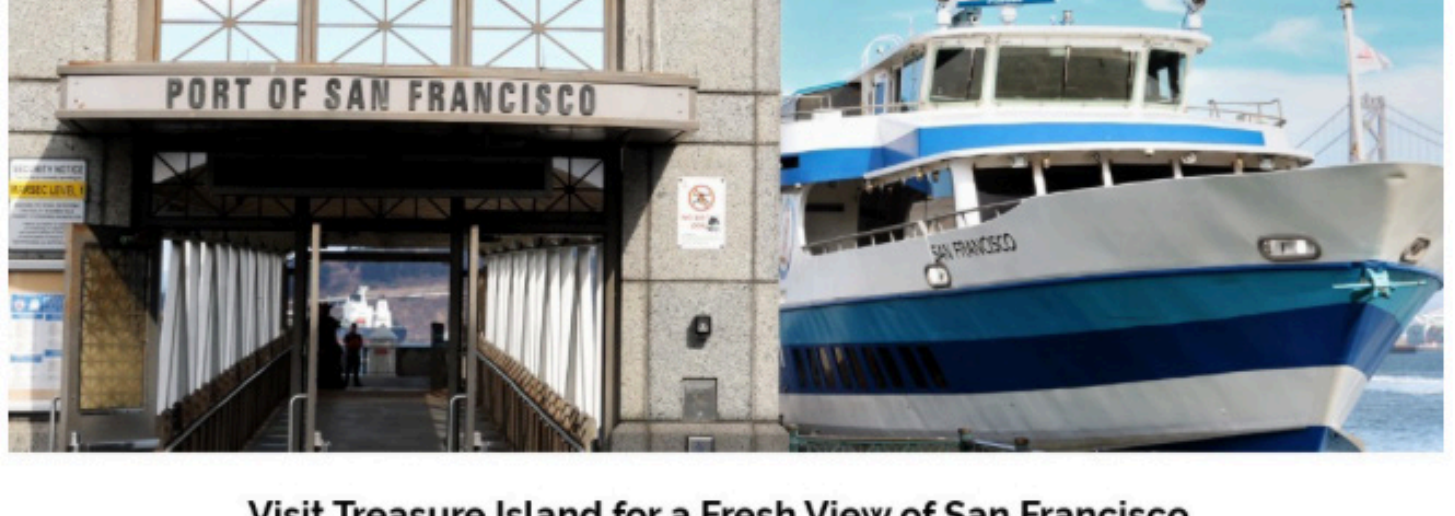

Celebrate the United States' 250th Anniversary on Angel Island

In celebration of the 250th Anniversary of the United States, Angel Island State Park is hosting special activities for the entirety of the long weekend. Enjoy music and food, living history activities - including cannon firings (!) - and visits by descendants with personal connections to the island's history. Activities will be at various locations along a paved 5-mile road, which visitors can reach by scenic bike ride or hike, and by paid shuttle service to the US Immigration Station. Other recreational possibilities include bike rentals, swimming, kayaking, and tram tours.

For evening events, reservations are required and service is provided by Angel Island Ferry from Tiburon.

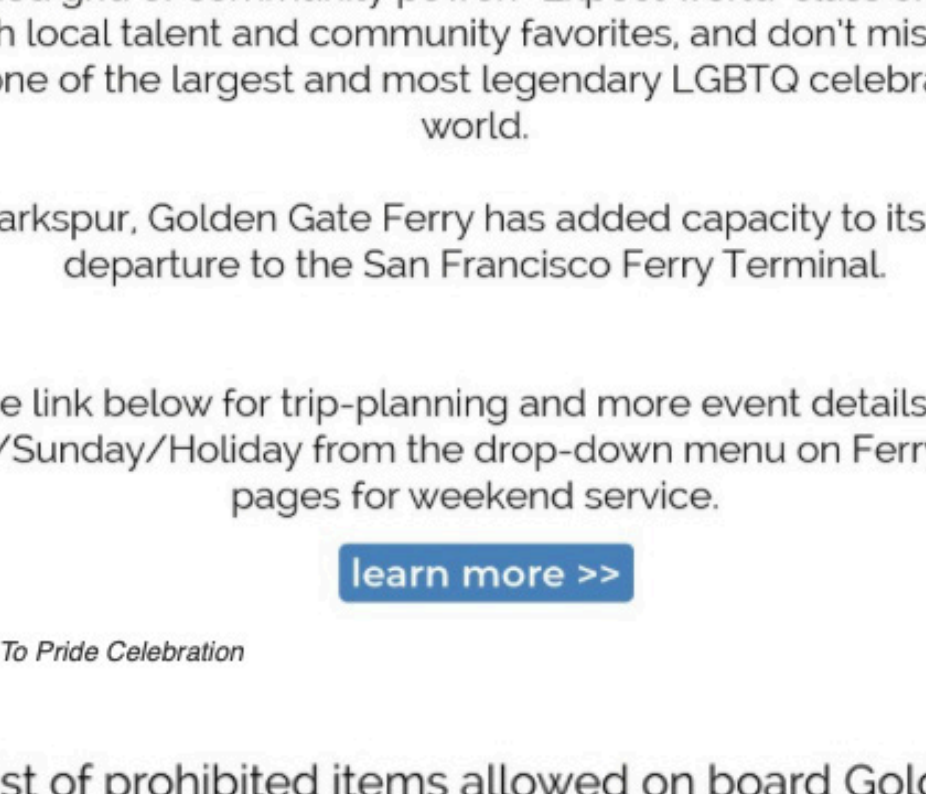

Treasure Island in San Francisco Bay is a man-made island built for the 1939 Golden Gate International Exposition. At the San Francisco Ferry Building, connect to Treasure Island Ferry for a scenic eight-minute ride to the island. Treasure Island offers breathtaking panoramic views of the city skyline, making it a premier spot for photography and picnicking. Visitors can enjoy waterfront dining, explore culture and history at the Treasure Island Museum, sip local wines, experience public art, enjoy the island's parks, and engage in outdoor activities like biking, kayaking or paddleboarding in Clipper Cove.

Enjoy this Year's Pride Celebrations with Public Transit

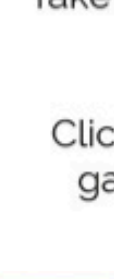

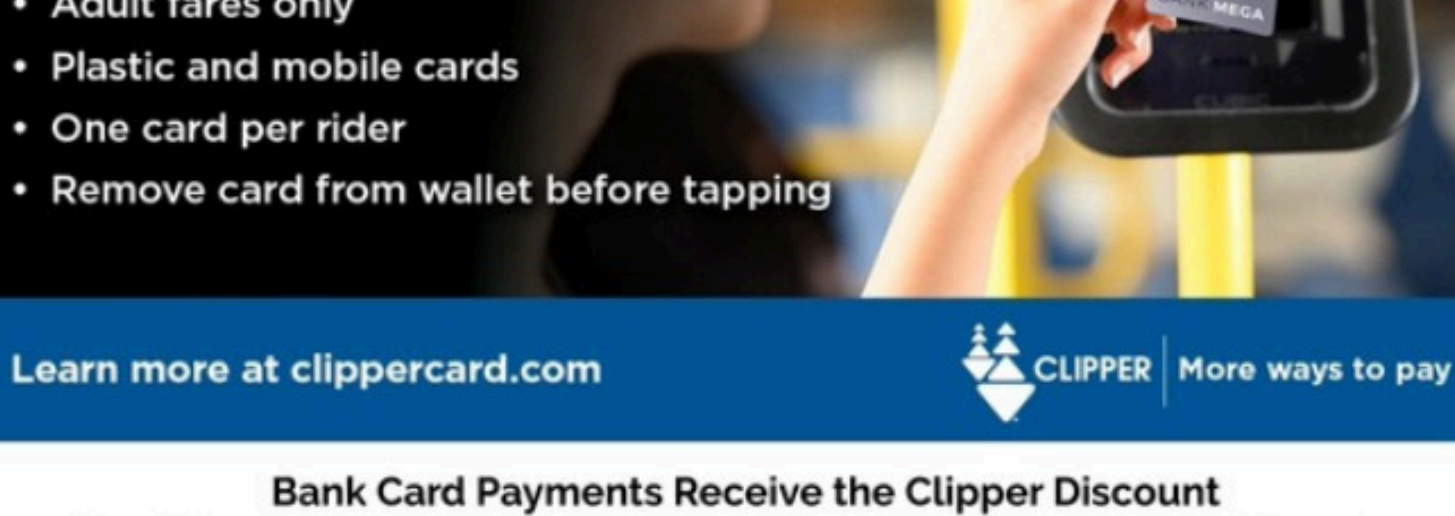

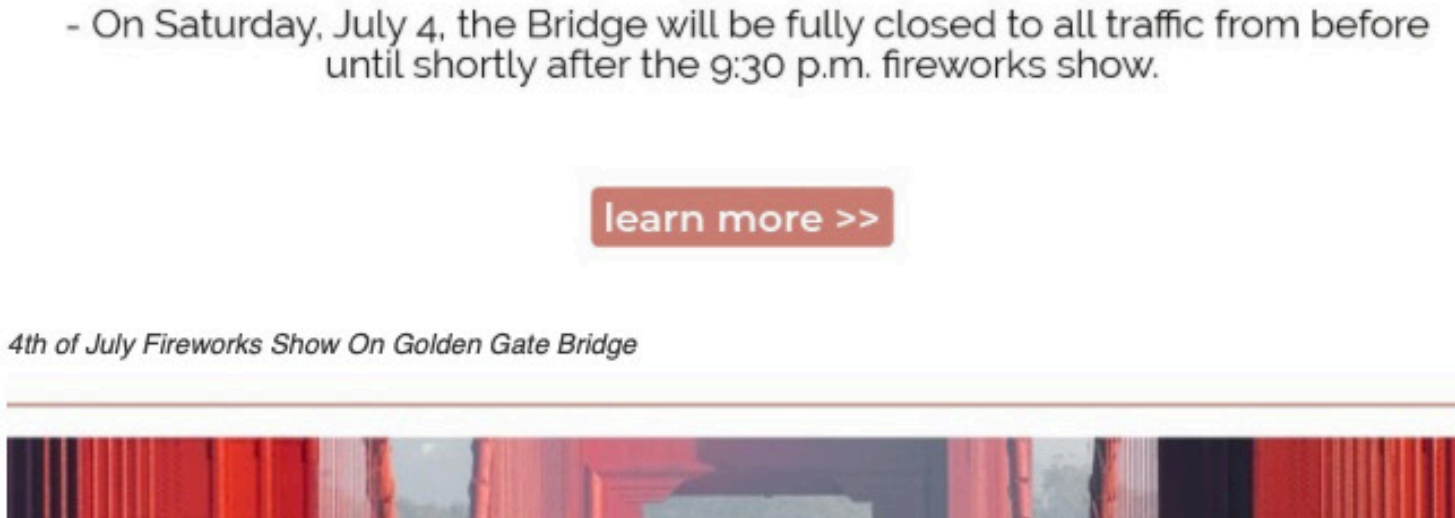

Golden Gate Bridge Toll Rates Increase July 1

On Wednesday, July 1, 2026, Golden Gate Bridge toll rates will increase by 50 cents as part of a multi-year program approved by the Golden Gate Bridge Board of Directors in March 2024. Every Bridge toll collected supports the operations & maintenance of this important gateway between the North Bay and San Francisco, as well as Golden Gate Transit and Golden Gate Ferry operations.
