APPROVE ACTIONS RELATIVE TO THE
AWARD OF CONTRACT NO. 2014-BT-1,
GOLDEN GATE TRANSIT SAN FRANCISCO
MID-DAY BUS PARKING FACILITY CONSTRUCTION,
TO WEST BAY BUILDERS INC.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors (Board) of the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District (District) operates Golden Gate Transit (GGT) bus service, which provides peak and off-peak weekday commute and weekend bus transit service between Marin and Sonoma counties and the City and County of San Francisco; and,

**WHEREAS**, the District presently stores its buses during the day at a leased lot located at Eighth and Harrison Streets in San Francisco; and,

**WHEREAS**, the District must vacate this present San Francisco mid-day storage location by the end of February 2014; and,

**WHEREAS**, the District negotiated and, as authorized by Board Resolution No. 2009-108, executed in December 2010 a long-term lease agreement with the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) for a parcel between Third, Fourth, Perry and Stillman Streets in San Francisco to be used for the new San Francisco Mid-Day Bus Parking Facility; and,

**WHEREAS**, the District has to make improvements to the parcel to facilitate bus storage and operations at the new site, and Contract No. 2014-BT-1, *Golden Gate Transit San Francisco Mid-Day Bus Parking Facility Construction* (Contract No. 2014-BT-1) will implement these improvements; and,

WHEREAS, Contract No. 2014-BT-1 involves improvements including: constructing a concrete masonry block sound wall with landscaping along Stillman Street and a portion of Third Street; installing perimeter security fencing and access gates; bringing power to the site; constructing modular office units along Third Street; connecting water, sewer and power lines to the modular office units; installing and

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powering site lighting, security cameras and site security systems; constructing a new traffic signal at Third and Perry Streets; modifying the curbs and sidewalks around the perimeter of the site; removing on-street metered parking along Perry Street; and, reconfiguring Perry Street from one-way westbound traffic to one-way eastbound between Third and Fourth Streets; and,

**WHEREAS**, on June 4, 2013, Contract No. 2014-BT-1 was advertised for bids, and on July 9, 2013, two bids were received, opened and publicly read; one from West Bay Builders Inc., Novato, CA, in the amount of \$4,906,306.00 and one from Ghilotti Bros, Inc., San Rafael, CA, in the amount of \$4,998,777.00; and,

**WHEREAS**, following review of the bids, staff determined that the lowest bidder, West Bay Builders Inc., is responsive and responsible; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program Analyst has determined that West Bay Builders Inc., has complied with the DBE requirements, and that no contract-specific DBE goal was established for this contract; and,

**WHEREAS**, to fully finance Contract No. 2014-BT-1 at the proposed budget of \$9,100,000.00, a budget increase in the amount of \$4,100,000.00 is required, to be financed with \$3,280,000.00 Federal Transit Administration (FTA) grant funds and \$820,000.00 District reserves; and,

**WHEREAS**, the total project budget is financed with \$7,280,000.00 (80%) FTA grant funds and \$1,820,000.00 (20%) District funds, with the project budget breakdown, as follows:

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**WHEREAS**, the Building and Operating Committee at its meeting of July 25, 2013, has so recommended; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED** that the Board of Directors (Board) of the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District hereby authorizes the award of Contract No. 2014-BT-1, *Golden Gate Transit San Francisco Mid-Day Bus Parking Facility Construction* (Contract No. 2014-BT-1), to West Bay Builders Inc., Novato, CA, in the amount of \$4,906,306.00; and, be it further

**RESOLVED** that the Board hereby establishes a Contingency Fund, in the amount of \$490,630.00, equal to 10% of the contract award amount; and, be it further

**RESOLVED** that the Board hereby authorizes the General Manager to approve change orders to Contract No. 2014-BT-1, within the construction contingency budget of up to \$250,000.00 per single change order, with the understanding that any individual change order exceeding \$100,000.00 requires the concurrence of the President of the Board and the Building and Operating Committee Chair; and, be it further

**RESOLVED** that the Board hereby authorizes a budget increase in the FY 13/14 Bus Transit Division Capital Budget, in the amount of \$4,100,000.00, to be financed with \$3,280,000.00 Federal Transit Administration (FTA) grant funds and with \$820,000.00 District Reserves, for a revised total Project budget in the amount of \$9,100,000.00, as concurred with by the Finance-Auditing Committee at its meeting of July 25, 2013.
