RESOLUTION NO. 2008-067

APPROVE ACTIONS RELATIVE TO PETITION FROM AMALGAMATED TRANSIT UNION, LOCAL DIVISION NO. 1575, FOR RECOGNITION OF EMPLOYEE UNIT COMPRISED OF UNREPRESENTED NON-PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYEES, EXCLUDING MANAGERS, SUPERVISORS AND CONFIDENTIAL EMPLOYEES

July 25, 2008

WHEREAS, the General Manager has reported that the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District has received a petition from the Amalgamated Transit Union, Local Division No. 1575 (Transit Union) for recognition of an employee unit comprised of all of the remaining unrepresented non-professional District employees, to be represented by the Transit Union; and,

WHEREAS, the General Manager has reviewed the petition from the Transit Union, and is satisfied that the unit in question is an appropriate one for bargaining purposes and that there is an adequate showing of interest for the petition by at least 40 percent of the members of the employee unit; and,

WHEREAS, the General Manager is recommending that the Board of Directors ratify the determination that the group of unrepresented non-professional employees constitutes an appropriate bargaining unit and authorize that a secret ballot election be conducted by the State Conciliation Service, in keeping with customary practice at the District; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED that the Board of Directors (Board) of the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District hereby ratifies the General Manager's determination that an employee unit comprised of all of the remaining unrepresented non-professional employees, excluding managers, supervisors and confidential employees, is appropriate for collective bargaining purposes, relative to a petition from the Transit Union; and, be it further

RESOLVED that the Board hereby authorizes a secret ballot election to be conducted by the State Conciliation Service to determine whether or not of all of the remaining unrepresented non-professional employees desire to be represented by Amalgamated Transit Union, Local Division No. 1575.


